Body

1. With orange yarn, ch 2.
Round 1: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (6)
2. Round 2: (inc 1 sc) 6 times. (12)
3. Round 3: (sc 1, inc 1 sc) 6 times. (18)
4. Round 4: (sc 2, inc 1 sc) 6 times. (24)
5. Round 5: (sc 3, inc 1 sc) 6 times. (30)
6. Round 6: (sc 4, inc 1 sc) 6 times. (36)
7. Round 7: (sc 5, inc 1 sc)

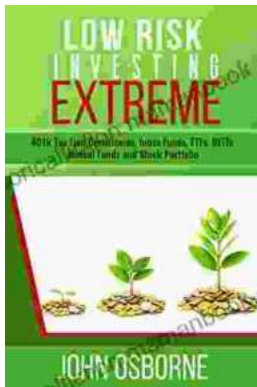
