Materials You'll Need:

- Worsted weight yarn in three colors: white, brown, and a contrasting color for the eyes
- Crochet hook size G (4.00mm)
- Yarn needle

- Scissors

Terminology:

- ch: chain
- sc: single crochet
- hdc: half double crochet
- dc: double crochet
- tr: treble crochet
- sl st: slip stitch

Crochet Pattern:

Body:

1. With white yarn, ch 2.
2. R1: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (6)
3. R2: (hdc, ch 2, hdc) in each sc around. (18)
4. R3: (dc, ch 2, dc) in each hdc group around. (36)
5. R4: (tr, ch 2, tr) in each dc group around. (54)
6. R5: (hdc, ch 2, hdc) in each tr group around. (81)
7. R6-15: Rep R5.

Eyes:

1. With brown yarn, ch 2.
2. R1: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (6)

3. R2: 6 sc in each sc around. (6)
4. Fasten off and make a second eye.

Beak:

1. With contrasting yarn, ch 2.
2. R1: 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (5)
3. R2: sc in each sc across. (5)
4. Fasten off.

Wings:

1. With white yarn, ch 21.
2. R1: sc in each ch across. (20)
3. Fasten off and make a second wing.

Assembly:

1. Sew the eyes and beak onto the body.
2. Sew the wings onto the sides of the body.
3. Fold the body in half and sew the sides together, leaving an opening for turning.
4. Turn the potholder right side out and insert a layer of batting or fabric scraps for added insulation.
5. Sew the opening closed and enjoy your charming vintage owl potholder.

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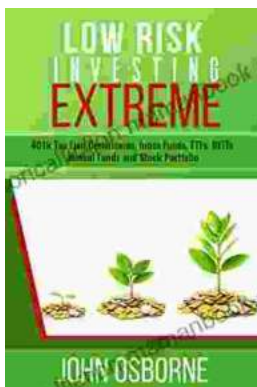
