 Knit 2, purl 2 rib for 12 rounds or until the cuff measures approximately 6 inches.

- Begin the striped pattern by knitting 1 round in Saffron 8ply yarn color A.
- 5. Repeat the following sequence for 6 rounds:
  - Knit 1 round in Saffron 8ply yarn color B.
  - Knit 1 round in Saffron 8ply yarn color C.
  - Knit 1 round in Saffron 8ply yarn color D.
  - Knit 1 round in Saffron 8ply yarn color E.
  - Knit 1 round in Saffron 8ply yarn color F.
- Repeat steps 4 and 5 until the striped pattern measures approximately
  6 inches.

#### Forming the Heel: A Secure and Comfortable Fit

- 10. Divide the stitches into two equal parts of 30 stitches each, placing a marker to indicate the division.
- 11. Knit the first 15 stitches, then turn your work.
- 12. Slip the first stitch purlwise, knit the next 14 stitches, then turn your work.
- 13. Repeat steps 12 and 13 until there are 6 stitches remaining on the lefthand needle.
- 14. Bind off the remaining 6 stitches.
- 15. Repeat steps 11-15 for the other half of the stitches.

#### Knitting the Gusset: Shaping the Sock

- 17. With the right-side facing, pick up and knit 10 stitches along the side of the heel flap.
- 18. Knit across the 10 stitches of the heel flap.
- 19. Pick up and knit 10 stitches along the other side of the heel flap.
- 20. Continue knitting in the round until the gusset measures approximately2 inches.

#### Knitting the Foot: The Foundation of Your Slipper Socks

21. Continue knitting in the round until the foot measures approximately 7 inches or desired length.

#### Decreasing the Toe: Shaping the Final Form

- 22. Divide the stitches into 4 equal parts of 15 stitches each, placing a marker at each division.
- 23. Knit to the first marker, then knit 2 together, knit 13, repeat this sequence to the end of the round.
- 24. Repeat round 23 until there are 12 stitches remaining on each needle.
- 25. Knit 2 together all around.
- 26. Repeat round 25 until there are 8 stitches remaining.
- 27. Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail, and thread it through the remaining stitches. Pull tight to close the toe.

#### Weaving in Ends: A Finishing Touch

28. Weave in all loose ends with your tapestry needle to secure your slipper socks and give them a polished finish.



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
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
